A new era is upon us here in Maui County! All of us ocean-lovers are thrilled now that the new mineral-only sunscreen ordinance has gone into effect this month on October 1. What does this mean for beach and waterfall-goers? Now only zinc oxide and titanium dioxide-based sunscreens are legal for use. This law guards human health and also the health of coral, fish and all marine life we know and love by reducing the amount of harmful chemicals that make their way into the ocean ecosystem from beaches and streams where people swim. So, it's time to read your sunscreen ingredient labels and stop using products containing oxybenzone, octinoxate, avobenzone, homosalate and octocrylene. And remember, just because it says "reef friendly" doesn't mean it is, so please read ingredient lists closely. The County of Maui is working with retailers to have them remove these products from their
